Next Tuesday 14 October 2014, the Fédération des femmes cheffes d'entreprise au Luxembourg (FFCEL) is celebrating its 10th anniversary; this is an opportunity to revisit all the organisation's past achievements and look forward to the future of the association.

Founded in 2004 at the initiative of the UEL (Union of Luxembourg Enterprises) and the Ministry for Equal Opportunities, FFCEL is set up as a non-profit association. Achieving equal opportunities for men and women in the Luxembourg economic and social environment is the biggest wish of FFCEL.

To achieve this objective, the FFCEL wishes to:

- Promote the role of women in entrepreneurship
- Encourage the inclusion of women in leadership positions in various sectors of the economy
- Help women expand their network, in Luxembourg and abroad
- Influence spheres of government to promote political and social vision of women to create value and employment

The Board of Directors of the FFCEL chaired by Madame Christiane Wickler is renewed every two years.

The FFCEL has 200 members representing 11 nationalities and 18 different business sectors; it has created 2,942 jobs.
